Mandatory Guidelines for In-Person Learning

Mitigation Practices (For everyone in the building)

- 3-6 ft social distancing spacing
- Masks worn 3rd grade and above, including all adults
- A goal to have all students K-2 learn to wear a mask at appropriate times
- Handwashing
- “Cohorting” students by grade level to decrease interaction
- A home screening process for families and staff before coming to school
- A school screening process for students and staff when they first arrive
- A school walking traffic flow plan for movement within the building
- Bathroom schedules
- Working with BLC to be sure common areas are cleaned and ready for the next group
- Others as we develop them

Expectations of Students and Families

All students will continue completing assignments using Google Classroom while at school. They will need to:

- Bring their laptops when they return. (Laptops will typically stay at school unless the child is ill and cannot participate in-person).
- Follow all dropoff and pick up procedures as requested
- Be connected to Class Dojo for updates
- Make certain your contact information stays up-to-date in case we need to contact you for any reason throughout the day
- If your child displays any symptoms of covid 19, allow them to stay home

Expectations of Staff

All teachers are expected to:

- Prioritize keeping our students safe by following all guidelines for learning in person
- Create a schedule to include those who are learning virtually at home
- All normal expectations of their position

Uniforms

All students will be expected to wear their uniform to school
